The world record for the spacewalks was more than 82 hours outside in space. That's almost $3 \frac{1}{2}$ days of walking in space! NASA astronaut Michael Lopez holds the U.S. record for the most spacewalks. He has done 10 spacewalks and spent more than 67 hours.


