The key to getting along with others is good communication skills. This is true at home, at school, and at work. Communication is one of the biggest challenges in relationships between men and women. Researchers say that the main problem is different communication styles. Men and women have very different communication styles. Understanding the differences can help men and women communicate more effectively.

Men's communication style is more direct. They usually take a direct approach to a problem and suggest a solution. Men often make decisions more quickly than women. They also prefer to make decisions by themselves. Women's communication style is to discuss problems and ask other people for **their** opinions. Women like to talk with other people before they make a decision.

The topics of conversation are also different between men and women. Women like to discuss personal issues and talk about their feelings. Talking about problems is important in friendships for women. Even at school or on the job, women are more comfortable talking about personal topics and feelings.

Men, on the other hand, are less comfortable discussing their feelings. Many men don't like to talk about emotions and feelings. Men like to talk about current events, business, and personal **accomplishments**. In conversations, it is important for men to see who the leader is in the group. Men often talk about important things they have done. Men build friendships by doing activities together. On the other hand, women build friendships by sharing feelings.

How do these different communication styles cause problems in relationships? There are several ways. First, women may think it is important to discuss how they feel about a problem. Men, however, prefer to come to a solution. Second, men often think that women are complaining, because women want to continue talking about their feelings. Men offer a solution to a problem, and then want to talk about something else. The third problem is those women often think that men don't want to discuss things. Actually, men just want to discuss different things. As men and women learn more about their different communication styles, they can better understand each other.

The discovery that the seeds of some plants can be eaten had an important effect on man's development. it made him realize that he could stay in one place and grow some of his own food .the grains of the wheat plant form the basic ingredient of bread . The other ingredients of bread are yeast, sugar, water, salt and fat. In Europe bread is usually made in many stages . The first stage is to make what is called "dough". The yeast is mixed with sugar and water then added to flour, salt and fat. All these ingredients are then pressed with the hands for about ten minutes until they form a large ball of dough.
