

Steve Jobs was a very good student at school. He graduated from high school at the age of 17. Then he began his studies in Reed College, in Portland, but he dropped out after six months. Deciding to **quit** university was not easy at all. It was difficult, but as Jobs later said, "I had no idea what I wanted to do with my life." Two years later in 1974, he travelled to India. **There**, he met a friend who became later his top employee in Apple.

After Steve Jobs returned to the United States, he found a job as a videogame designer at a company called Atari. After two years, in 1976, when he was only twenty-one, he created his own company – Apple Computer – with his friend, Steve Wozniak. Steve Jobs later got married in 1991 and had four children. Unfortunately, doctors discovered that he had cancer in 2003 and he died in 2011.

Banks are places where people can keep their money. Most people use banks to save money in their savings accounts, and to pay money from their checking accounts. In the past, people used to receive their salaries by hand. They also used to save their extra money at their homes. This was not safe, and people couldn't make use of their savings. Yet, things have changed greatly nowadays. Today, when a person earns money from their job, his salary is often electronically **deposited** into his saving accounts.

People nowadays can pay their bills by writing cheques from their checking accounts or pay online where their bills are electronically connected to their bank accounts. Banks also give loans to people. **They** lend people to buy new houses, cars, or to start businesses.

The bank makes money from lending their customers by charging interest. In other words, people have to pay back more than they borrowed. This amount depends on how risky the bank thinks the borrower is and how fast the loan is paid back. The riskier the borrower is, the more charging interest he or she would pay the bank.


