VI- Reading Comprehension (110 Marks)

Read the following passage carefully, and then answer the questions below:

- (1) I am *Peter G. Peterson*. The turning point in my life came before I was born. It was the day in 1912 when my Greek-immigrant father came to America. He came as a teenager, without a penny or a word of English, and with only a third-grade education.
- (2) He remained jobless for a long time. His engagement in a minority group, constituting a very small fraction of the population of the country helped him earn his living. Finally, he took a job as restaurant dishwasher. He worked, ate and slept in a steam train caboose. He was determined to save everything he made. With his savings he opened a small restaurant and kept it open 24 hours a day a week for 25 years in my hometown of Kearney, Nebraska. His hard work and *thrift* gave extraordinary opportunities and a good example of a successful struggle against poverty. Had I been born in a different country, at a different time, I would never have had the chances that gave me such good fortune.
- (3) I have lived the American Dream- I went to college, worked in the business world, served in government and became an investment banker. And that led to a second turning point, on June 21, 2007, at 9.30 a.m. That was the day I founded the Black Stone Group, a combination of two private management and financial companies. In an hour, I became an instant billionaire.
- (4) What to do with so much money? I have much more than enough, and there seems little hope that I can take <u>it</u> with me. So again, I turn to my father's example. When he had built a modest net worth, he gave generously to his old home in Greece and to the less fortunate in his beloved new home. Tears would come to his eyes when he sang "God Bless America." He so loved America for its possibilities.
- (5) I believe today that those possibilities are shrinking the American Dream. So, I have chosen to put much of my wealth into a new foundation which will propose workable solutions. I cannot think of anything more important than trying in this way to preserve the possibilities of the American Dream for generations yet to come.
