Can \ could \ be able to \ manage to

- We use can \ can't \ could \ couldn't + infinitive to talk about abilities in the present and the past

• نستخدم هذه الأفعال المساعدة للتحدث عن المقدرة في الزمن المضارع والماضي

- I can run 100 meters in 12 seconds. \ I can't drive.
- I could swim when I was four years old. \ The driver couldn't start the car engine.
- We use able to + infinitive to make other tenses and talk about other times

• نستخدم be able to مع الأزمنة الأخرى

♥ I haven't been able to walk since I broke my leg

♥ I hope I will be able to see better when I get my new glasses

- But we use manage to or be able to when we talk about particular occasion in the past. We often use these verbs when we achieve something that was difficult to do:

• نستخدم manage to و able to للتحدث عن أحداث كانت صعبة علينا بالماضي ولكننا تمكنا من حلها

♥ The door was locked , but we managed to get out by breaking a window
(Not we could get out)

♥ The engine wouldn't start. In the end we were able to start it by pushing it
down a hill. (Not we could start it)

- We usually use couldn't for negative sentence نستخدم couldn't للجمل المنفية
I couldn't drive a car when I was seven years old.

2- Intensifiers

* They are adverbs which are used to modify adjectives and adverbs.

• هي ظروف تستخدم لتوضيح مقدار تحقق الصفة أو الظرف في شيء معين .

* They come before the words they modify.

• توضع قبل الصفة أو الظرف الذي تصفه .



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

