LEGO toys were well made but Ole Kirk’s business was not doing well.

In 1940, Ole Kirk came up with a new idea and started making the first plastic toys, which became very **popular**. He invented a way to connect pieces with each other to build something. He wanted kids to be smart and think of ways to invent and make models.

Thanks to Ole Kirk and his sons, kids around the world enjoy playing with LEGO. Movie makers made many movies about LEGO. There are even a lot of entertainment parks for LEGO where families can play and enjoy their time there.
