Tomatoes can be round or oval or shaped like a pear. When they are ready, the fruit usually changes into red or yellow colour. The tomato **contains** many small seeds covered by a jellylike tissue. It has most of the tomato's vitamin C.

Despite the popularity of tomatoes, it was only 200 years ago, that they were thought to be toxic. When tomatoes came to Europe, people did not eat them. Doctors said that tomatoes would make people sick. Therefore, people just grew tomatoes because **they** looked nice. Now, people from all over the world eat tomatoes. Tomatoes are used in sauce, soup, juice, and ketchup.

Doctors advise people to eat tomatoes because these red fruits have many useful vitamins like vitamin A, which supports immunity, vision, and skin health. They are also a good source of vitamin K, which is good for the bones. Eating tomatoes may also help support heart health and weight loss.

Whether you enjoy them fresh in salads, cooked in sauces, or sun-dried, tomatoes are useful and can add flavour and colour to different dishes. So, go ahead and try the taste of these exciting red fruits!
